**Aim:**

Digital transformation (DT) covers more and more areas. In recent years, an increased development of Information Technologies (IT), especially Artificial Intelligence (AI) as well as their applications in accounting, finance and controlling (AF&C) processes has been observed. This applies to both systems and tools for business data analysis, as well as the use of tools for intelligent automation of financial and accounting processes.
